

PROPERTY ACCESS AGREEMENT
FOR
WRIA 53 – LOWER LAKE ROOSEVELT
GROUNDWATER LEVEL MONITORING PROJECT

The WRIA 53 Planning Unit is currently conducting a watershed based groundwater level monitoring project to assist with the understanding of the multiple aquifers located throughout northern Lincoln County. The Planning Unit, in cooperation with the Lincoln County Planning Department and the Lincoln County Conservation District, has requested access to private wells throughout the County for the sole purpose of gauging the depth to groundwater in the wells. Measurements will be collected every 4 to 12 weeks through June 2011.

This document serves as an agreement between the property owner and Lincoln County to allow access to the wells for gauging water levels. The following conditions are applied to access to the wells:

- Access to the wells will only be conducted on existing points of entries (e.g. field vehicles will remain on existing roads).
- No disturbance to the existing water supply will occur.
- Monitoring equipment will be cleaned prior to use on any well.
- The condition of the well will be returned to that found when arriving on-site.
- Notice will be given to the property owner a minimum of 24 hours prior to the site visit should the property owner request this notification.
- All data collected will be supplied to the property owner upon request.
