The bids will then be opened and publicly read at 10:00 a.m. at the Commissioner's meeting on Monday, February 25, 2013.

It shall be the bidder's responsibility to insure that their bid is delivered to the Board of County Commissioners prior to the deadline and receipted by the Lincoln County Clerk of the Board.

All bids must be submitted upon the attached Bidder's Proposal. Bidders shall complete every space in the BIDDER'S PROPOSAL COLUMN with either a check mark (✓) to indicate the item being bid is exactly as specified or a description to indicate any deviation of item being bid from the specifications.

Deviations or alternatives from the provisions of these specifications will be considered. Such deviations or alternates will be approved, however, only in the sole discretion of the County and only if, in their opinion, they do not adversely affect the strength, efficiency, effectiveness or life of the equipment. All proposed deviations or alternates, with full details, must be listed on the attached proposal that is part of the bid, unless otherwise noted. The listing of such deviations or alternates will indicate that no deviations from the specifications, except those that are listed as deviations on said bidder's proposal and which are expressly approved as part of the Board's acceptance of the bid.

The Board of Lincoln County Commissioners reserves the right to accept or reject portions of bids, to waive informalities or irregularities in the bids or in the bidding, if the best interests of Lincoln County will be served, or to accept the bid, which in their opinion best serves the interest of Lincoln County.

Bidders are advised that Lincoln County, being a municipal corporation is exempt from Federal excise tax.

The price quoted shall include all transportation charges fully prepaid to the Lincoln County Public Works equipment yard located at 27234 SR 25 N., Davenport, WA 99122

Availability date of the equipment will be a consideration in the acceptance of the bid.

The unit bid and all equipment, lights, signal and safety devices shall meet OSHA and MSHA standards and requirements.

The County of Lincoln hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively insure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, minority business enterprises will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated for or against on the grounds of race, color, sex or national origin, in consideration for an award.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Award Date: The award date shall be the date when the Lincoln County Board of County Commissioners execute the Commissioners' Order approving the acquisition.
2. Order Date: The order date shall be the date upon which the Public Works Director or his designee signs the form ordering the equipment.
3. Interpretation: Should discrepancies or omissions be found in the specifications, or any doubt as to its meaning, the bidder shall notify the Public Works Director in writing. The Public Works Director will send written instructions or addenda as required to all interested parties and they shall be incorporated into bid documents.

GENERAL SPECIFICATIONS

Any units not conforming to bidders exact specifications will be rejected and it will be the responsibility of bidder to conform to the requirements unless deviations have been specifically cited by the bidder and acceptance made on the basis of the exception.

DELIVERY: Price must include delivery to the Lincoln County Public Works equipment yard at Davenport, Washington. Unit shall be delivered complete with all accessories and components in full operating condition.

WARRANTY: Consideration will be given to units offered with a "free of charge" warranty. If offered, the Warranty period, terms, and specific items covered must be stated on the equipment furnished.

EQUIPMENT CONDITION: Overall condition will be taken into consideration.

GENERAL TERMS: Appurtenances and/or accessories not herein mentioned but necessary to furnish a complete unit ready for use upon delivery shall be included in the bid and conform in design, strength, quality of material, and workmanship to what is usually provided on the type of unit offered. The units furnished shall include, but not be limited to, factory standard equipment and those optional items as specified.

DESIGN AND CONSTRUCTION: Units shall be original equipment as of the date of manufacture. Any deviation from original manufacturing specifications (i.e. component alterations and/or the addition of non OEM parts) shall be noted.

TAXES: All applicable taxes must be shown when called for in proposal. It shall be the dealer's responsibility to furnish Federal excise tax exemption certificate, when applicable.

PAYMENT: Payment will be made within 30 working days after delivery and final acceptance by Lincoln County.

AWARD OF CONTRACT: The right is reserved by the Lincoln County Board of Commissioners to reject any or all bids, to waive informal ties in the bidding, and to accept in whole or in part such bid or bids as may be deemed in the best interest of the County. The Board will not be bound necessarily by the low bid. No bidder may withdraw his bid after the hour set for the bid opening unless award is delayed for a period exceeding thirty (30) days.

VENDOR ERRORS: Any vendor pricing, configuration or other proposal errors discovered after bid opening must remain and cannot be adjusted.

GUARANTEES: Dealer and Company shall warrant that the unit and all auxiliary equipment shall conform to the specifications and be free from defects in material, workmanship and title.
